Application Guidelines for the 2022 Chinese Government Graduate Student Overseas Study Program Scholarship

Juntendo University will carry out the following 3 programs based on the Chinese Government Graduate Student Overseas Study Program conducted by the Chinese Scholarships Council (CSC).

I Doctoral program

A program to obtain a doctoral program at Juntendo University

II Joint instruction program

A program to conduct doctoral thesis research under joint instruction at Juntendo University in a research field closely related to the doctoral thesis research conducted at a university of students enrolled in a doctoral course of a university in China

III Joint research program

A program in which researchers from Chinese universities conduct joint research at Juntendo University The details of the application process are as follows.

I Doctoral program

1. Eligible courses

(1) Graduate School of Medicine Doctoral Program (acceptance period: 48 months [4 years])

2. Start of Enrollment

April 2022

3. Intake

Up to 20 students a year for the whole university

4. Eligibility for application

Applicants must meet all of the following conditions.

- (1) Applicants eligible to apply for the CSC's Chinese Government Graduate Student Overseas Study Project
- (2) Applicants who meet the entry requirements of the doctoral program of the Juntendo University graduate school in which they wish to enroll
- (3) Applicants who have received permission to apply from their desired Juntendo University academic advisor
- (4) Applicants with an excellent academic record
- (5) Applicants who understand that they will not be able to use other scholarship programs after being accepted under this program because this scholarship is not permitted to be used alongside other scholarships

5. Application documents

Please complete the following application documents in Japanese or English.

- (1) Application form (in the attached format)
- (2) Letter of recommendation (style is optional but a letterhead is required)
 - The recommender should be the head or academic advisor of the university to which the applicant belongs (or used to belong).
- (3) Resume (with photo)
- (4) Certificate of Graduation (prospected graduation) or Certificate of Completion (prospected completion) (or a copy thereof)

- Applicants who have completed (or are prospected to complete) a program with a minimum of 5 years of study in medicine, dentistry, pharmacology, or veterinary medicine must submit a Certificate of Graduation (prospected graduation) from their undergraduate school.
- Applicants who have completed (or are prospected to complete) a master's program must submit a Certificate of Graduation (prospected graduation) for both undergraduate and master's programs.
- Applicants who are prospected to graduate from an undergraduate program or complete a master's program at the time of application must submit a Certificate of Graduation or Completion as part of the Graduate School enrollment procedures after passing the entrance examination.
- (5) Degree certificate (copy)
 - Applicants who have completed (or are prospected to complete) a program with a minimum of 5 years of study in medicine, dentistry, pharmacology, or veterinary medicine must submit an undergraduate's degree certificate.
 - Applicants who have completed a master's degree should submit degree certificates for both undergraduate and master's degrees.
- (6) Academic transcript (copy)
 - Applicants who have completed (or are prospected to complete) program with a minimum of 5 years of study in medicine, dentistry, pharmacology, or veterinary medicine must submit an academic transcript from their undergraduate school.
 - Persons who have completed (or are prospected to complete) a master's program must submit academic transcripts for both undergraduate and master's programs.
- (7) Official score report for language tests (JLPT, TOEFL, TOEIC, IELTS)
- (8) Copy of passport

Notes

If documents (4), (5), and (6) can only be issued in Chinese, applicants must prepare a translation (English or Japanese) and have it notarized at a public institution such as a local notary public office in China.

8. Exemption from tuition and other fees

Admission examination fees, admission fees, and tuition during the doctoral program (up to standard term of study) will be exempted.

What is the standard term of study?

• Doctoral Program, Graduate School of Medicine: 4 years

9. Notice of selection and scholarship recommendation

- After submitting the scholarship application form, applicants must then take the entrance examination for the doctoral course of the Juntendo University graduate school in which they wish to enroll.
- We recommend applicants who passed the entrance examination for a doctoral program of a Juntendo University graduate school with particularly excellent results to the CSC as CSC scholars.
- After the nominee is selected, the applicant will be notified of the selection results by e-mail and the scholarship recommendation letter will be sent.
- Applicants who have received a scholarship recommendation letter should apply to the CSC for the Chinese Government Graduate Student Overseas Study Program.
- If you have passed the CSC screening, please submit a copy of the Chinese Government Graduate Student Overseas Study Program acceptance certificate issued by CSC (Chinese and English) to Juntendo University International Center.

II Joint instruction program

1. Eligible courses

(1) Graduate School of Medicine Doctoral Program (acceptance period: 6 months to 24 months [2 years])

2. Start of Enrollment

October 2022

3. Intake

Up to 5 students a year for the whole university

4. Eligibility for application

Applicants must meet all of the following conditions.

- (1) Applicants eligible to apply for the CSC's Chinese Government Graduate Student Overseas Study Project
- (2) Applicants currently enrolled in a doctoral program at a graduate school of a university in China who are able to obtain a letter of recommendation from their current academic advisor for study at Juntendo University.
- (3) Applicants who wishes to study abroad for the purpose of being enrolled as a special research student in a doctoral program at a graduate school of Juntendo University and receiving research supervision from an academic advisor of Juntendo University
- (4) Applicants who have received permission for acceptance from their desired Juntendo University academic advisor
- (5) Applicants who have either Japanese or English proficiency, meet one of the following language criteria, and are able to submit the certificate:

① TOEFL iBT: 76 or more ② IELTS: 6.0 or more ③ TOEIC: 700 or more ④ JLPT: N3 or higher

 - Please submit the latest academic transcript of your current university.

If documents (4) and (5) can only be issued in Chinese, applicants must prepare a translation (English or Japanese) and have it notarized at a public institution such as a local notary public office in China.

Tuition fees will be exempted during the doctoral course.

- After the successful applicants are selected, they will be notified of the selection results by e-mail and the scholarship recommendation letter will be sent.
- Applicants who have received a scholarship recommendation letter should apply to the CSC for the Chinese Government Graduate Student Overseas Study Program.
- If you have passed the CSC screening, please submit a copy of the Chinese Government Graduate Student Overseas Study Program acceptance certificate issued by CSC (Chinese and English) to Juntendo University International Center.

 - Postdoctoral fellow (acceptance period: 6 months to 24 months [2 years])

3. Intake

Up to 5 students a year for the whole university

4. Eligibility for application

Applicants must meet all of the following conditions.

- (1) Applicants eligible to apply for the CSC's Chinese Government Graduate Student Overseas Study Project
- (2) Applicants who are enrolled in a university or research institute in China and who can obtain a letter of recommendation from the head of the university or research institute.
- (3) Applicants who have received permission for acceptance from their desired Juntendo University academic advisor

(4) Applicants who have either Japanese or English proficiency, meet one of the following language criteria, and are able to submit the certificate:

① TOEFL iBT: 76 or more ② IELTS: 6.0 or more ③ TOEIC: 700 or more ④ JLPT: N3 or higher

(5) Applicants with a certain level of research achievements who meet the following criteria:

Visiting scholar: Applicants with a master's degree or higher and two years or

more of work experience (education/research) at the university

or research institution to which they belong

Postdoctoral fellow: Applicants with a doctorate degree that has been acquired within

less than three years at the time of application

- (6) Official score report for language tests (TOEFL, IELTS, TOEIC, JLPT)

Please submit certificate (5) in Japanese or English. If the certificate can only be issued in Chinese, applicants must prepare a translation (English or Japanese) and have it notarized at a public institution such as a local notary public office in China.

You will be exempted from research fees while you are enrolled at Juntendo University.

- Applicants who have received a letter of acceptance should apply to the CSC for the Chinese Government Graduate Student Overseas Study Program.
